Background:

Working with Professor Marshall Ganz and the Bloomberg Harvard City Leadership Initiative, Professor Lerner and her team have developed a scale that measures the ability to motivate others and publicly share meaningful information about oneself—in short, success in generating a public narrative. This ability to generate and deliver a public narrative is distinguishable from other personality traits and is noticeable to outside observers. Responsibilities:

Working with Professor Lerner and her team, this student will be responsible for: 1) Fully understanding the background and goals of this project; 2) Performing literature reviews in the fields of leadership, personality, and narrative identity; 3) Writing summaries of the research literature; 4) Coding, analyzing, synthesizing, and presenting qualitative data; and 5) Reading and editing draft manuscripts.

Review of applications begins immediately and will take place on a rolling basis.

Required qualifications:

- Outstanding academic record in Psychology, Government, English, or related fields;
- Strong writing skills;
- Excellent organizational, interpersonal, and communication skills;
- Demonstrated interest or research experience in psychology;
- Undergraduate level statistics course
- Ability to dedicate 6-10 hours/week to this project;
- Must be a current undergraduate student at Harvard College.

Preferred qualifications:

- Experience conducting thorough literature reviews and independent research in psychology or a related field.
